

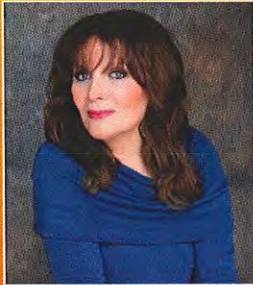

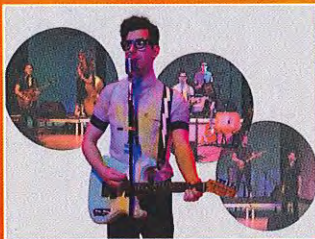

Saturday, September 15, 2018 at 7:00 pm

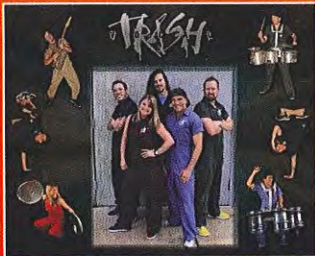
